



Student Policy

Cell Phones and Electronic Devices: Students are not permitted to use cell phones or electronic devices while in the classroom. No exceptions. This includes listening to music, making phone calls, messaging, taking pictures/videos, social media interaction, browsing the internet. If a student needs to make a phone call for emergency purposes, please go to the office. Students caught using their cell phone or electronic device will be disciplined with a referral and immediate removal of the phone for the remainder of the day. All collected cell phones and electronic devices will be brought to the Principal, along with a written referral. The student will see the Principal at the end of the day to retrieve their cell phone or electronic device.

Dress Code: All students are to adhere to the dress code policy. Hats, scarves, durags and hoods are not to be worn in the building. Undergarments should not be visible. For further understanding of the Dress Code Policy, please refer to the Student Handbook.

Food and Drinks: Students are not allowed to eat or drink while in the classroom. Students arriving early to eat breakfast must remain in the cafeteria while eating. Late arrivals must follow the same protocol. Students are not allowed to roam the hallway while eating.

Internet Browsing: Students are not permitted to use the internet for entertainment purposes. Students are not allowed to be on YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, SnapChat, game sites, etc. Students caught browsing the internet for non-educational purposes will be sent to the Principal or the Dean of Students with a referral.

Classroom Behavior: Students are to behave in an appropriate manner while in the classroom at all times. Students are to keep their voices at an appropriate and respectable tone while in the classroom. There should be no loud talking, screaming, singing, dancing, fighting, arguing, or horse playing. Students conducting inappropriate behavior while in the classroom will be sent to the Principal or the Dean of Students with a referral.
